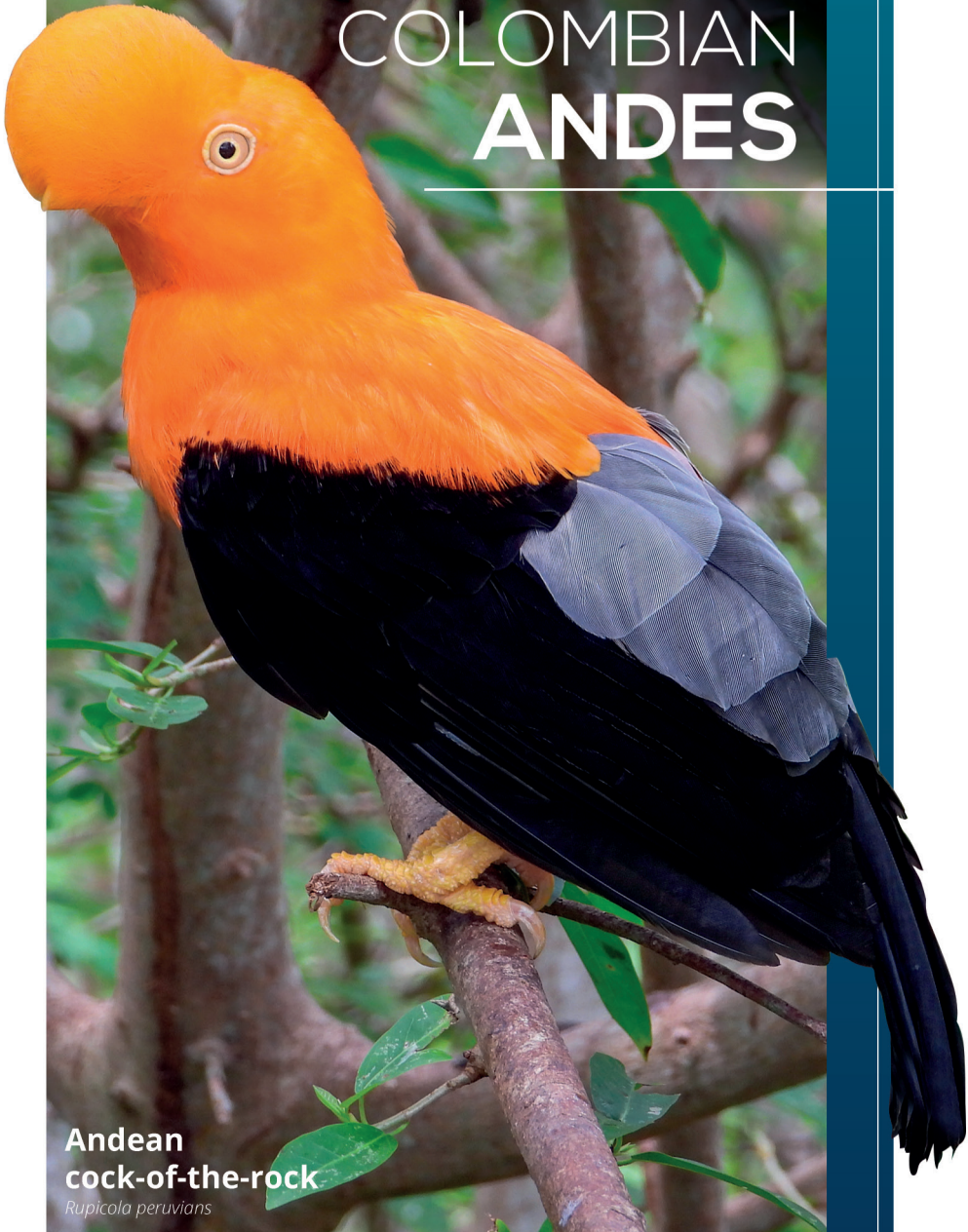

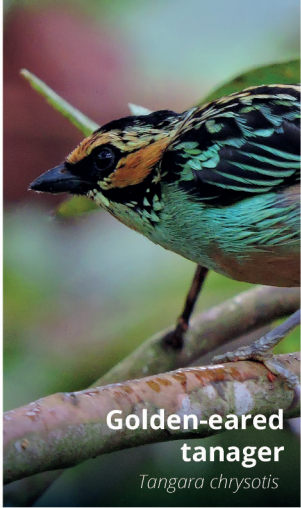

## General tour + information

This tour lasts 20 days. We will visit different areas of our country with a wide variety of weather, so we strongly recommend you bring sets of clothes suitable for cold weather (paramo 4 °C) to tropical weather.

We start before dawn and spend long days looking for all of our precious birds. Sometimes we will offer packed breakfast and picnic lunches to extend birding time.

Long walking distances are not expected and our vehicles will be close to us all the time. Nevertheless, we will have long periods of bird watching standing up.

## DAY 1

Arrival to Bogotá. If you have the time and energy, we can take you on a special sightseeing tour downtown.

● 2.600m ● 55,4°F   

## DAY 10-11

We will spend the next 2 days in El Cairo, an awesome enclave for birds and all kinds of flora and fauna.

● 1.800m ● 68°F  

## DAY 12

After leaving El Cairo, we will go south towards Laguna del Sonso to keep doing some birdwatching in this spectacular place. We will spend the night there.

● 1.000m ● 82,4°F  

## DAY 2

Day trip to La Calera and Guasca, two birdwatching spots, and then back to Bogotá.

● 2.600m ● 50°F  

## DAY 8-9

We will drive a couple of hours to the Otún Quimbaya sanctuary, where we will spend 2 days watching a wide variety of birds and butterflies. At the end of the second day, we will go to El Cairo.

## DAY 13

Early in the morning we will go to La Cumbre, just 2 hours away. Here we will be able to see a wide variety of birds. We will spend the night there.

## DAY 20

We will take a flight back to Bogotá to end our amazing tour.



## DAY 3

We will go to Tena to visit the Laguna de Pedro Palo, our birdwatching place for the day.

## DAY 6-7

Bird watching morning in Chicaque before heading to Cañón del Corbeima, an amazing spot to watch some of the most unique species in Colombia.

## DAY 14

We will take the old road to the port of Buenaventura, also known as Anchicayá. We will arrive to Finca El Descanso, a paradise where we will be able to see at least 12 hummingbird and 8 tanager species. We will spend the night close to Cali.

## DAY 17-19

We will spend the next 3 days discovering places around Mocoa like the Sachamates route, Trampolín de las Aves and Fin del Mundo, watching the most amazing birds in the region.

## DAY 4

We will depart from Bogotá to visit three birdwatching spots: Parque La Florida, San Francisco (Jardín Encantado), and La Vega (Laguna del Tabacal).

## DAY 5

From Bogota, we will head to Chicaque, a magical forest and birdwatching place near the city, where we will spend the night.

## DAY 15

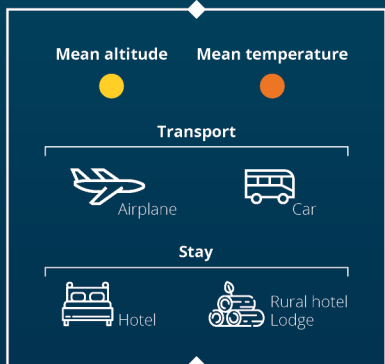
Early in the morning we will leave Cali to Finca Alejandría, a magic spot where we will be able to see 32 different species of hummingbirds, several species of tanagers and toucans, among others. We will return and spend the night close to Cali.

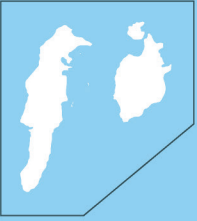
## DAY 16

#### Included in the tour

#### Prices

- + Starting from 5.900 USD.

- + 7 - 8 pax: 5.900 USD pp

#### Book

To ensure a spot in the tour you will have to fill out a form and to make a non-refundable deposit or transfer to our bank account (1.500 USD). Full payment of the tour fee is due 90 days prior to the tour departure date.

#### Cancellation policy

If you have to cancel your trip, we have the following options:

If the cancellation is made between the start date of the tour and 90 days before, you will forfeit the total deposit (USD 1,500).

If the cancellation is made more than 90 days before the start of the tour, you can reschedule a new trip within a year. If you do not reschedule within a year, there will be no refund.



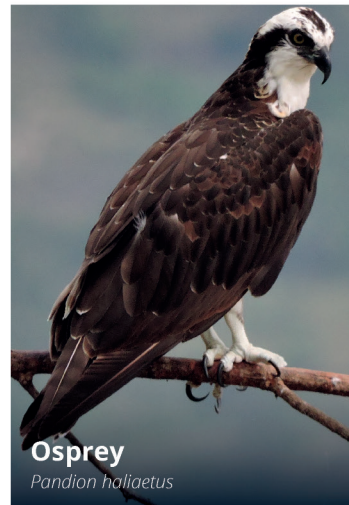

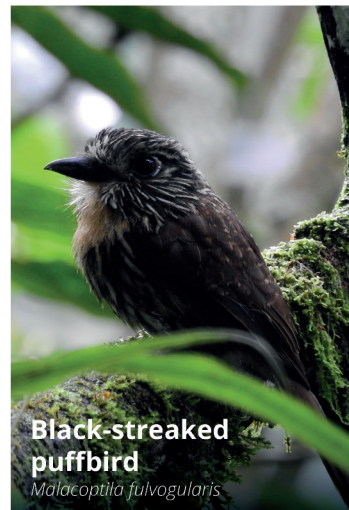

## Recommendations



- + Use insect repellent before starting any activity and reapply during the day, and wear long sleeved shirts and trousers in order to protect your whole body if needed.
- + You don't need any vaccination certificate when you travel to Colombia; however, because of the characteristics of some particular destinations, specific vaccines may be required; we strongly recommend to confirm with us prior to your trip (e.g. yellow fever, typhoid and hepatitis A).
- + Bring the following basic equipment (essentials).
  - A hat, lightweight and waterproof jacket (dark colored), sunglasses, hiking boots.**
  - Sunscreen.**
  - Your camera and equipment. If you don't have one we can rent it to you! Ask for the different options.**
- + Keep your personal belongings with you at all times (passport, money, equipment, etc.)
- + All our tours provide basic travel insurance; we highly recommend a personal travel insurance policy that provides sufficient medical and security coverage according to your needs.
- + You will need a valid passport to come to Colombia. Please verify that your passport is valid for at least six months after your intended return date. If the expiration date is uncomfortably close to the cutoff, make sure you renew it ahead of time. Travelers from some countries have to present a visa for entering Colombia; please check.
